## MPTA Disappointed at Failure to Pass Constitutional Amendment 7

The Missouri Public Transit Association (MPTA) endorsed Constitutional Amendment 7, which, for the first time, would have provided an identified and ongoing source of funding for public transit throughout the state.

Association President, Tom Mogelnicki, said, “MPTA is disappointed that the citizens of Missouri did not approve this historic amendment to the constitution. Adequate ongoing funding for public transit and a comprehensive multimodal transportation system remains one of the most significant challenges facing the state. We will continue to work with other organizations to identify and pursue solutions to the problem.”

The Missouri Public Transit Association was founded in 1980 to represent the interests, policies, requirement and purposes of public transportation in Missouri and values personal mobility as a basic quality of life.
